I have to acknowledge the favour of your letter of the 25<sup>th</sup> January with the accompanying parcel & extract from the letter of Monsieur Fufs Secretary of the Imperial Academy of Science of St Petersburg

Having communicated that extract to the Managers of the Royal Institution and laid before them <sup>the</sup> various parts of the Transactions of the Imperial Academy accompanying it, I am directed to request that you will have the goodness to transmit to M Fufs the thanks of the Managers for his prompt and complete attention to their request, and especially for his kind offer in regard to the extract from the

proceedings of the Imperial Academy, which he has proposed to transmit to the Royal Institution from time to time in the form of a letter, and to assure him that this "Bulletin Scientifique" will be most acceptable to the Managers, and will be most thankfully received, either through the Foreign Office, by means of our Minister at the Imperial Court, or through your kind instrumentality, as most agreeable & convenient to M. Fup.

I am further directed to transmit to M. Fup for the Use of the Imperial Academy, the first two numbers of the Journal of the Royal Institution, the regular transmission of which immediately on its publication in future has been ordered.

The Managers also desire me to convey to you their thanks for the ready & effectual manner in which you have promoted this object in opening a correspondence with the Imperial Academy

through all steps, and doubt not that from it  
may result consequences beneficial to the interests  
of Science.
