Propterea & nos, Balthici maris accolæ, DEi beneficium non possumus grata mente non agnoscere, qvi Evangelii lucem & rerum publicarum florem concesserit, literarumq; splendorem nobis accendere & conservare, atq; ex barbarie & erroribus benigne nos eripere voluerit. Agnoscunt id præter alios Nobiliss. quidam inter Lubecenses Viri, Eruditionis fama conspicui, qvi divinum hoc beneficium deprædicaturi, & cum orbe literato felicitatem maris Balthici communicaturi, laudabili prorsus conatu *Nova Literaria maris Balthici* colligere instituerunt. Et cum ipsæ artes per se conservari aut propagari non possint, nisi divinum Numen ingenia hominum excitet, eaq; ad artes conservandas confirmet; igitur dum artes deprædicant, non possunt hominum, omnis scientiæ, conservatorum, oblivisci: & dum ipsam scientiam, quæ Balthici litoris accolæ commendat, magnificiunt, ipsos etiam literatos posteritati commendare non desinunt. In quem finem & ipsi *Lubecam Literatam* superiori

anno exhibuerunt, &, ut alii etiam, quis-
que suæ patriæ præstarent, optarunt. Se-
cutum inde est *Dorpatum* in nostra re-
gione *Literatum* cum *Riga Literata*. Et
nunc nobis etiam *Revaliam Literatam*,
nulla officiorum vel dignitatis ratione
habita, & nominibus tantum Alphabeti
ordine dispositis, exhibere placuit, ut, per
quos inter Revalienses jam liberalium ar-
tium studia vigeant, notum existat. Omni-
bus interim votis optamus, ut autor & sta-
tor artium liberalium ulteriora urbi & re-
gioni nostræ incrementa liberaliter indul-
gere, ingeniaq; ulterius præclara instru-
ere & ornare velit, ut inter nos vigeant
artes, earumq; flores & fructus commu-
nicari etiam cum aliis possint. Tandem
si nomina fortassis *Literatorum* quorun-
dam, qui hic loci degunt, in hac descri-
ptione non legantur, cum notitia eo-
rum nos fugiat: vel etiam, si præter opi-
